THE PRACTICE OF THE FEAR OF THE LORD

Isaiah must learn how to practise the fear the LORD in his life and ministry.

- 1. He must focus on the LORD of hosts
- 2. He must "hallow" the Lord
 - a) To regard Him as the LORD
 - b) To sanctify the LORD God in his heart
- 3. He must fear (dread) the LORD
- 4. He must make God his sanctuary

The fear of the LORD can be learned. When we learn how to do this, we will become that much stronger in our outlook of life.
