

A SONG WRITER

Moses was also a song writer. One of his songs was found in Deuteronomy 32.

"Give ear, O heavens, and I will speak;
And hear, O earth, the words of my mouth.

² Let my teaching drop as the rain,
My speech distill as the dew,
As raindrops on the tender herb,
And as showers on the grass.

³ For I proclaim the name of the LORD:
Ascribe greatness to our God. Deuteronomy 32:1-3

- 1. His song was valuable for more than just its tune
- 2. He was deeply committed to teaching about the Lord
- 3. It was the LORD who had personally proclaimed His mighty name to him (Exodus 34)
- 4. It was his turn to proclaim God's name
