

## THE PROMISE OF THE SECOND COMIING OF THE LORD JESUS

There were some who expressed doubts as to whether this promise would be fulfilled. The Apostle Peter wrote this word to instruct and encourage all believers.

- <sup>8</sup> But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day *is* as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day.
- <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

2 Peter 3:8-9

- 1. Our reckoning of time
  - a) Human reckoning of time is different from God's reckoning
  - b) One day with God is like 1000 years in human time reckoning
- 2. God is not slack in fulfilling His promise
  - a) If the Lord Jesus would return right now, many souls would be lost
