

A CHALLENGING TEXT

The Apostle Peter wrote a word that proves a little puzzling.

¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up.

¹¹ Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness,

¹² looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat?

¹³ Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

 - ii) These things must be fulfilled!
 - iii) When we fulfil what God wants us to do, we "hasten" the Day of God
 - iv) This does not mean that we can "hurry God" in any way!

Let us seek to fulfil our part. The following are things we are supposed to do:

- 1. We must bear witness
- 2. Let us share the Gospel with conviction
- 3. We must endure suffering if needs be

REOPENING OF SUNDAY SCHOOL IN JULY 2022

We have suspended onsite Sunday School for almost two and a half years. Praise the Lord for His safe-keeping and protection thus far. Thank God also for all our Sunday School teachers and AVA team for their strong support and hard work in making online lessons available to our students during this period. We want to express our deep appreciation to each one!

With the recent Government's lifting of safe distancing and other restrictions, we have been able to progressively resume various Church ministries onsite. We will now resume Sunday School for all departments with effect from 3 July 2022.

Please take note of the following:

- 1. Sunday School starts punctually at 8.30 am and ends at 9.15 am.
- 2. Mask wearing is required.
- 3. MWS will be from 10.00 am to 11.00 am... it will revert to 10.30 am after our Church Anniversary celebrations in August 2022.

 - b. There is still quite a high number of Covid-19 cases in Singapore, so we want to be cautious; and
 - c. We are also concerned for the safety of those who are not vaccinated.
- 5. Bethany's kitchen is still undergoing renovations. So, breakfast will not be served initially. Instead, we will be providing some biscuits for children who may be hungry. Please feel free to pack breakfast for your child if there are food restrictions or preferences.

We seek your understanding.
