ORDINATION TESTIMONY #1 JONATHAN JACOB

Dear brethren,

ANNIVERSARY GREETINGS

A blessed and joyous 40+9th Anniversary to all who are part of Bethany! Thank God for this special occasion which we can all celebrate together!

AN ESPECIALLY MEMORABLE DAY

This day is extra special and memorable because I am also being ordained as a Pastor for the Lord's work. I am deeply grateful for God's amazing grace extended to me. I am deeply humbled by the tremendous love, care, and support shown by our Bethany family. As I reflected on the past 5 years of Pastoral Training, some key lessons came to mind. Please allow me to share some of these lessons with you through this testimony.

YIELDING TO THE LORD'S CORRECTION

5 years ago, before I was commissioned as a Student-Pastor, I had wrong practices and ideas of ministry. I served in my own strong spirit and personality. Moreover, I did not know how to follow the leading of the Spirit of God. The way I handled the Word of God was not accurate either. My way of life needed to change too. Just as the disciples of the Lord Jesus needed to be corrected of much in their formative years of training (Luke 6:40), I too needed to be corrected of much in these 5 years. One of the lessons we learned was that we may be "lacking in our faith" (1 Thessalonians 3:10). These years of training have allowed me to acknowledge the different areas which I have been lacking in, receive correction for them, and attempt to change.

HANDLING THE WORD OF GOD CORRECTLY

One of the key features of Pastoral Training is spending time learning at the feet of Pastor Charlie at our Morning Classes. These opportunities allowed me to observe how he read and interpreted the Word from the Bible. Each outline he crafted provided an opportunity to understand how he rightly divided a passage. Every time Pastor explained and exegeted a text accurately, it gave me an example to follow. Pastor has been kind and gracious in correcting my wrong approach in handling the Scriptures. He has been showing me what it

means to rightly divide the Word of truth. He is my example of someone who diligently presents himself as approved to God and as a worker who does not need to be ashamed (2 Timothy 2:15). I'm also learning about the importance of taking heed to what the Spirit of God teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual (1 Corinthians 2:13). I recognize that the old way of interpreting God's Word erroneously needs to be done away with. The thought of becoming like the "priests who were without knowledge" (Hosea 4:6; Malachi 2:7) frightens me. Humbly and contritely, I admit that I have been a slow learner, but I am committed to learning how to understand a text precisely, apply it, and make it relevant for others.

BECOMING A LOVING AND CARING SHEPHERD

The Pastoral Team and Church Staff have been examples to me as to how I can learn to love and care for the brethren here in Bethany. I'm learning from the way they bring themselves down to the level of children as they relate to them. I noted how they make themselves approachable and relatable to young people. I also noted that they keep in touch with young adults to understand their different needs and challenges. I further noted how they listen, care, and encourage the older ones in Bethany. And finally, I noted how Pastor devotes much time to minister to the churches here in Singapore and overseas. I am learning to be such a shepherd. One that cares, knows, and loves his sheep (John 10). I was given a glimpse of how to be a caring shepherd as I kept in touch with the seniors who attended the Special Seniors Program which commenced in 2022. Our dear seniors have struggled with health challenges and the effects of Covid-19 Safety Measures. I learned what it meant to listen to them and love them. I know that there is still so much more to learn and make a part of my life and ministry but I desire to keep growing so that I can become a shepherd who shepherds according to the integrity of his heart, and guides by the skillfulness of his hands (Psalm 78:82).

CONCLUSION

As I am ordained today, I am fully aware that it is not the end of a journey but a significant milestone in a journey which continues. I am committed to learn deeper lessons, grow further, and cultivate ministry skills to serve the Lord Jesus Christ and His people. As I look beyond ordination, I am challenged to walk worthy of the calling with which I was called (Ephesians 4:1). I pray that the Lord may graciously strengthen and uphold me to remain faithful to His calling!



The Day the Lord Spared My Life

17 August 2022 was like any normal day when I drove off to work in the morning at around 6am in my car.

At around 6.10am, I reached a normal turning lane which I usually would turn into. That morning was unusual, as each of the lanes in my opposite direction was filled with stationary vehicles (the lanes were normally empty in the early hours) and the lane closest to me was a white van.

From my point of view, the traffic light was turning amber, and at that split second I inched my car forward, anticipating the green arrow to signal me to turn right. It was then I noticed the white van has its headlights flashing non-stop for that few seconds when I was inching forward. Before I knew it, the white van was coming quickly head on towards my car's direction and all I could hear after that was an extremely loud crash. My car shook at the impact the

crash created and right before me was an inflated cloth bag (the air bag from the steering wheel) that blew into my face. At this point, I really thought that the Lord was taking me home or that my spine which previously underwent two major surgeries for slipped discs would be so injured that it would cause me a lifetime of paralysis. After about 5 seconds or so, my car came to a halt and I composed myself to see that my car windscreen was smashed to smithereens on the left side. I unbuckled myself from the driver's seat, opened the car door and got out of the car. What happened in the next few minutes were history- I managed to inform my family of the accident before the ambulance came as the shortness of breath, tightness in my chest and the pain from the multiple bruises from the crash caught up with me. One woman passer-by in particular was extra sympathetic towards me saying, "The other party is ok! But look at you, you have wounds...poor you!" The paramedics then tended to me and I was taken to the nearest hospital for further treatment.

In the 2 days I spent in the hospital before I was discharged as the doctors found no serious injury and broken bones in me, I was looking through the photos taken by my sister of the aftermath of the accident:

My 12-year-old car had its front left tyre sticking out of alignment with the right side of the bonnet and both headlights smashed beyond their original shapes. The car was so badly damaged that no one would have thought that anyone would have walked out of the car without a single drop of blood...but I did. I suffered only superficial wounds and abrasions in this serious accident.

It was at this point I realised how the Lord had protected me in such a miraculous way. That few seconds of misjudgement, be it on my part or the van driver's, could have led to very fatal consequences. Instead, the Lord in His grace and mercy, preserved a small safe spot in the accident-wreaked car for my whole body to remain intact and alive. This is truly the amazing grace of God.

This anniversary week, I am reminded through this accident where I nearly had a brush with death, of how in the tumultuous times of life, the Lord protects us in such marvellous ways through the known and unknown dangers and risks we

face every day. This accident has truly strengthened my faith to say that the Lord is indeed my Shield and my Protector. It has further convinced me that God has saved me and spared my life truly, for His Divine plan and purpose.

As a stanza of the hymn 'Amazing Grace' puts it:

Through many dangers, toils, and snares
I have already come
This grace that brought me safe thus far
And grace will lead me home.

Truly, in this short 41 years of my life, the Lord has seen me through so many trying times and challenges I faced with my health, work, relationships and even my physical safety. Without His amazing grace, I would not be here today giving thanks for all He has done for me. In this recent accident that happened this week that is leading up to Bethany's 49th anniversary, I have only praises to offer to our Great God who not only impacts my personal faith in such profound ways, but also the faith of the church as a whole for His glory and purpose. Without the faithful preaching and teaching of God's Word through His servants week after week and day after day, my faith wouldn't have grown significantly through this past decade. I believe this is true for those serving and being served in all the ministries in Bethany, be it in Singapore or overseas. I truly thank God for Bethany, a church where I can strengthen my faith in the Lord and grow closer to our Saviour who will lead me safely to my eternal Home one day.

Blessed 49th Birthday, Bethany. May the Lord continue to grow the ministries the church has started for His kingdom and glory.
